Young Americans for Liberty is hosting their second annual FREE liberty Poker Night aimed to spur a campus wide discussion on gun rights and the right to protect yourself on campus.

This year, Oak Grove Gun Shop in Eugene donated a .40S&W Sig Sauer handgun. Mazama Gun Shop donated a Weatherby Vangaurd 243 Rifle with a Simmons Scope 3.5-10/40.

More than ever, the discussion pertaining gun crime and gun control on campus is relevant. This event will serve as a form of protest against the University's gun control policies that put students in harm's way.

The State Board of Higher Education in 2012 approved a policy that prohibits the possession of firearms on property controlled by any of the state's seven public universities. This rule was adopted in 2014 by the University of Oregon's Board of Trustees.

University of Oregon does not allow students to carry or possess weapons on campus, including students with a concealed carry license. Students with concealed carry licenses, however, are permitted to carry concealed weapons on post-secondary campuses by Oregon Law.
