### WHAT IS MAVS STAND-UP?

MAVS Stand-Up is recognizing a potentially harmful situation or interaction and choosing to respond in a way that could positively influence the outcome.

### WHY IS MAVS STAND-UP IMPORTANT?

At UTA we believe that everyone has a role to play to keep our community safe. MAVS Stand-Up can help to create a safer campus and empower students, faculty and staff to recognize and reduce harm. Empowering students, staff, and faculty to be active bystanders can help in a number of ways, including:

- Empowering individuals to recognize and respond to signs of suicide
- Addressing high-risk drinking among college students
- Creating a culture where hate speech, bias incidents, and harassment are not tolerated
- Minimizing the risk of sexual assault and interpersonal violence
- Reducing the likelihood of hazing incidents
- Creating an inclusive environment for students with disabilities
- Connecting individuals to important resources and services
