Dear Zach,

Thank you again for your continued patience. Please accept this email as the College's response to your letter dated March 9, 2026. In your letter, you demand that the College "lift all sanctions on fraternity and sorority chapters stemming from the November 12 event." I write to inform you that all but one of the College's Greek life chapters have completed the training that was required of them following the November 12 incident. Accordingly, as to those groups, your demand to "lift all sanctions" is now moot. As for the remaining chapter that has not completed the requisite training, if the chapter completes the training, they will be able to resume all functions as well.

The College remains steadfast in its position that requiring training was an appropriate response to the November 12 event. The College does not agree with the characterizations of the training in your letter, and it rejects any assertion that it violated any applicable federal, state, or local law or any College policy or process. Rather, the College's response was an appropriate response to the event and was consistent with the College's deep commitment to complying with all applicable federal and state anti-discrimination and anti-harassment laws and fostering an educational and employment environment free from discrimination and harassment in all their forms.
