Due to reports of alleged violations of the Student Code of Conduct that our office received, the following actions are being taken that impact your status as a student at Rockland Community College pending disciplinary proceedings:

1. You are TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED from Rockland Community College effective immediately, Thursday, November 2, 2023, for 4 business days. TEMPORARY SUSPENSION means that you are prohibited from attending classes and participating in activities at Rockland Community College. Additionally, you are considered TEMPORARILY PERSONA NON GRATA. Persona non grata means that you are not permitted to be on any RCC campus without prior approval from the Executive Director of Student Engagement and College Life and Public Safety. If you violate this persona non grata status, you will be subject to arrest.
2. You are required to make an appointment with Dr. LaToya Blount, Executive Director of Student Engagement and College Life ([REDACTED]) before the end of your temporary suspension for a conduct meeting.
3. A hold has been placed on your account. You will not be permitted to register for classes or receive transcripts until this matter has been resolved.
