
I write in response to your email to Dr. Joy Smith, regarding Clemson University's Sales and Solicitation policy and the judicial case involving Clemson Conservatives. First, the Sales and Solicitation Policy and other policies related to facility and space use are under review. Therefore, I am removing the admonition and censure sanctions placed on Clemson Conservatives and directing the Office of Student Conduct to destroy the file related to this discipline case.

Second, while we are in an active process to review our policy, changes cannot take place overnight. For this reason I distributed a statement yesterday that enables campus affiliates to assemble peaceably. We welcome your suggestions regarding the policies concerning facilities and space use at Clemson, and you should feel free to direct your specific recommendations to myself or George Smith.

Andrew, as I understand it your email is the first request from Clemson Conservatives regarding changing the policy and removing the sanctions. In the future, if you want FIRE or any other outside group to speak on your behalf, please make this known to me in writing. That way I will be clear on your intentions.
