Dear Joseph:

The fact-finding process has been completed. As such, you are charged with violation of the following Oakland University policy:

#6.02 Unlawful Individual Activities: No person shall engage in any activity, individually or in concert with others, which causes or constitutes a disturbance, noise, riot, obstruction or disruption which obstructs or interferes with the free movement of persons about the campus or which interferes with the free, normal and uninterrupted use of the campus for educational programs, business activities and related residential, food service and recreational activities, nor shall any person in any way intimidate, harass, threaten or assault any person engaged in lawful activities on the campus.

This alleged behavior is considered very serious by the University, and you are advised to prepare your defense with care and to carefully review the Student Conduct Code in the Student Handbook (HYPERLINK "http://www.oakland.edu/deanofstudents/handbook/index.cfm" \t "_blank" www.oakland.edu/deanofstudents/handbook/index.cfm).

The University Conduct Committee will hear your case. The hearing is scheduled for Friday, January 6, 2012 at 1PM in room 125 Oakland Center and should last approximately two hours.

Michael Latcha will chair the University Conduct Committee which includes:

In reference to item #5 I understand that I can challenge at least 24 hours prior to the hearing via written notification or by telephone, without explanation, the presence of one committee member. The committee member challenged will not participate in the hearing.

In reference to item #9 of the Student Rights Checklist for Nonacademic Conduct Matters you have indicated to me you do not want to have an adviser.

4. You need to inform me of any witnesses you will present at the hearing at least 48 hours prior to the hearing. You may call me at HYPERLINK "tel:%28248%29%20370-3352" \t "_blank" [\(248\) 370-3352](tel:(248)370-3352).

This letter and its attachments will also be provided to the committee. The hearing and deliberation will take place in two parts. The first part will address the charge and decide responsibility. If you are found responsible, the second part will determine an appropriate sanction. Possible sanctions are listed in the Student Handbook.

Please contact me if you have additional questions regarding this process. I want to remind you that failure to attend the hearing might result in a sanction rendered without your direct involvement.
