

Section 4(f) (6) of County Ordinance 238-1984 states that “No person shall, at any facility: Interfere with, encumber or obstruct passage to any entranceway or exit of a facility.” Section 2 (a) of County Ordinance 238-1984 defines “facility” to include Nassau Community College. Section 4(k) of County Ordinance 238-1984 states that “Any person who remains on the premises of any facility and refuses to leave upon the lawful request of any duly authorized representative of the facility or a police officer shall be guilty of trespass.”

Pursuant to the above sections of County Ordinance 238-1984 and reflecting the intention, as stated on the website of the Nassau Community College Federation of Teachers, of individuals to engage in collective activity in the proximity of the Nassau Community College Tower Building, an area has been designated for such a gathering on the Plaza proximate to the Tower Building that will not interfere with, encumber or obstruct passage to any entranceway or exit to or from the Tower Building or adjoining buildings.
