Dear Mr Kissel,

I am responding on behalf of President Genshaft and Dr. Jennifer Meningall, our Vice President for Student Affairs, regarding your inquiry surrounding the proposed application and recognition of the Young Americans for Freedom organization at our Tampa campus. I also want to thank you for providing additional information (Sharon Statement of Purpose) that distinguishes the mission of the Young Americans for Freedom student organization that has been proposed at the University of South Florida.

After further review by the Center for Student Involvement at the University of South Florida, it has been determined that the Young Americans for Freedom organization meets the requirements for provisional status to establish a new student organization on campus including a roster of five registered students, a full time faculty/staff advisor, and an organization mission.

To obtain full active status, the organization must follow the established process as follows:

1. Submit an organization constitution to be reviewed based on the Constitution Guidelines here <http://www.involvement.usf.edu/pdf/conguide.pdf> to the Center for Student Involvement in the Marshall Student Center Room 3302 or email an electronic document to ednamiller@usf.edu.
2. Once the constitution is approved, an organization representative will be contacted to attend a Bull Session, which is a short informational meeting with a staff person from the Center from Student Involvement with regard to student organization policies and procedures.
3. Thereafter, the organization will be granted full active status.
