The University has been informed that you have allegedly made statements during class that are not related to course content, and if confirmed, would violate University policies, including but not limited to the policy prohibiting sexual harassment.

During this administrative leave, the University will be investigating these allegations. While on leave, you will not be teaching the Drug Wars course. You should not discuss this matter with any University employees and you should not have contact with any students. You are directed to contact my office immediately to schedule a time to discuss with me how you and the division will address your other University responsibilities while you are on leave. You should also make arrangements with me prior to visiting in your office or other locations on campus.
